- Achieve a minimum overall high school GPA of 2.0.

ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

DIVISION I ONLY:

- 1 extra year of English, math, or science;
- 10 of the 16 core courses must be completed before the start of the seventh semester (i.e. senior year) of high school.
- 7 of the 10 core courses must be English, math or natural or physical science.
- Meet the sliding scale of core-course GPA (minimum 2.30) and SAT/ACT sum score

DIVISION II ONLY:

- 3 additional years of English, math, or natural or physical science
- Meet the sliding scale of core-course GPA (minimum 2.20) and SAT/ACT sum score
