FAQ

Q: Is pre-registration required and does my student have to attend after school care?

A: Any Junior High student, not picked up by an adult by the 3:10 bell, must report to after school care. After school care is a walk in service and does not require registration.

Q: Is after school care open even if no students report to after care?

A: No. After school care is a walk in service and is only open as needed. If the last student in after care is picked up at 4pm, the aftercare closes at 4:10pm.

Q: Can my student report to after school care at the end of sports, music or club meetings?

A: Parents are expected to pick students up from all extracurricular activities. If you know you will need assistance please notify the coach, office or Mary Polak, Junior High Extended Care Supervisor, so that appropriate arrangements can be made. Communication is key to your student's safety.

Q: Can my student sign themselves out of after school care.

A: Students must be signed out by an adult. No exceptions.

Q: Are snacks provided?

A: No. We strongly encourage students to bring a snack and refillable water bottle to school.

Q: Is after school care provided on half days, teacher in-service, or holidays?

A: No. After school care is only available on full school days.

Q: Will my student's time in after school care be structured?

A: Yes. A typical afternoon may look like: Free Time 3:10-3:30, Homework Hour 3:30-4:30 (Chromebook can be used for homework only, no gaming allowed during homework hour), and Open Time 4:30-6:00.

Q: How much does after school care cost?

A: \$2.00 per 30 minutes for 1 child, \$3.50 per 30 minutes for 2 children and \$5.00 per 30 minutes for 3 or more children in the same household. ***Please don't be late! There is a \$1.00 per minute charge when picked up past 6:00 pm.***
