SENIORS: Last Spring, Calvin offered a full, paid SAT prep course on Saturdays to prepare students for the exam which was cut short by the Coronavirus. As the school year has resumed, so has the class. This has provided a unique opportunity for students who did not pay for and partake in the full course in the spring to participate in a practice SAT test administered on campus three weeks before Calvin offers the real thing.

The test will be online, just like the actual exam. They can do it on their own for free on the Kahn Academy site, but if they wish to have a more formal experience, for \$15 (the fee for the last session of the class), Dave Bakker and Shelli Lundgren will provide the formal practice test on campus on Friday, September 25. They will time and proctor it to ensure a distraction free environment as well as provide feedback or strategies of how to handle difficult sections if they have questions of how to improve after seeing their projected score.
